





## 3 Number Combination Lock Opening and Changing Instructions






## (Factory Code 10 - 20 - 30)


- The lock should now be unlocked and you can operate the safe handle (if applicable) and pull the door open.
- To lock the safe turn the handle back to the original position and turn the dial left at least four complete turns.

## **Combination Changing Procedure**

\*Please read these instructions carefully before starting the process.

- 1. Locate the change key.
- 2. Dial the existing combination to the change mark (assuming 10 20-30). Leave the 3rd number of the combination stopped on the mark.
- 3. Insert the change key into the back of the lock body and turn as shown. (anticlockwise)
- 4. Dial the new combination to the change mark using the correct sequence of turns and ensure to be accurate.





- 5. Leave the 3rd number stopped on the change mark.

  Turn the change key back to the original position and remove it from the lock.
- 6. Test the combination by using the new numbers and the correct dialling sequence several times before locking the safe door.
